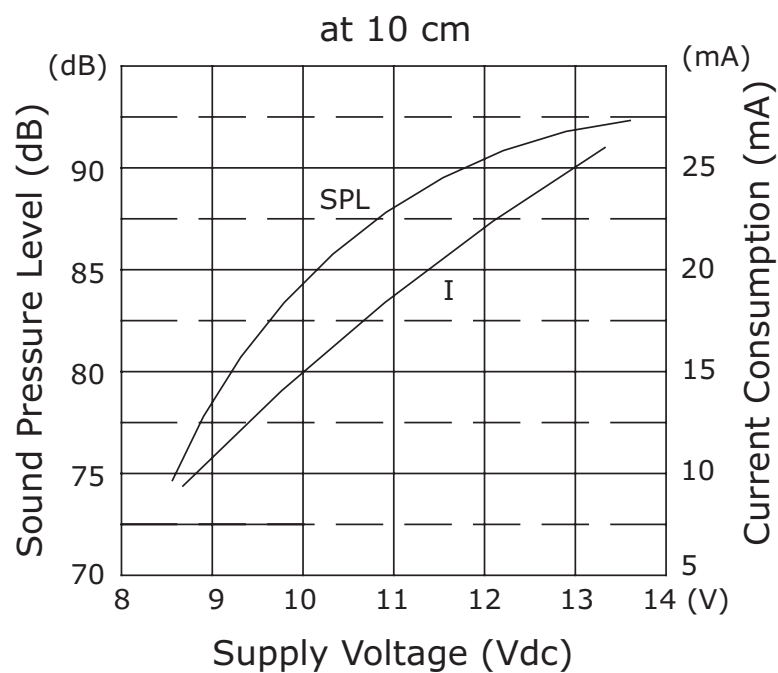

PERFORMANCE CURVES

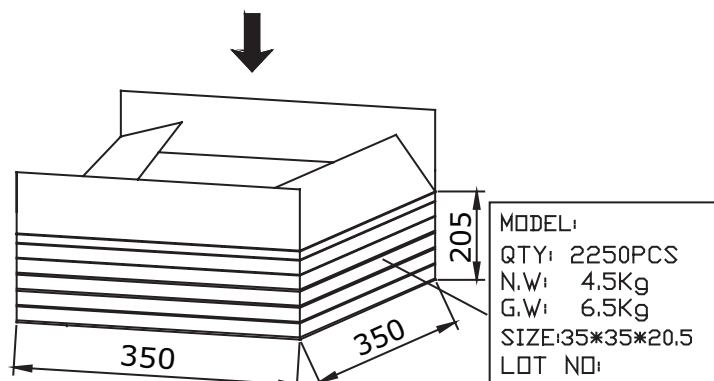
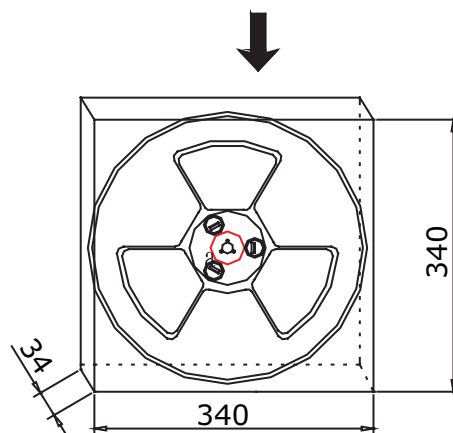
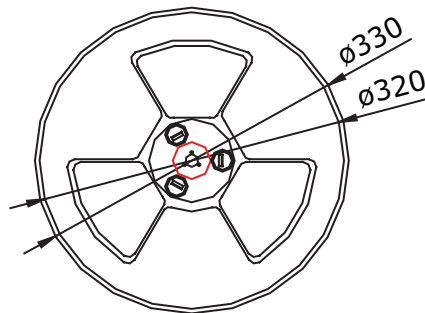
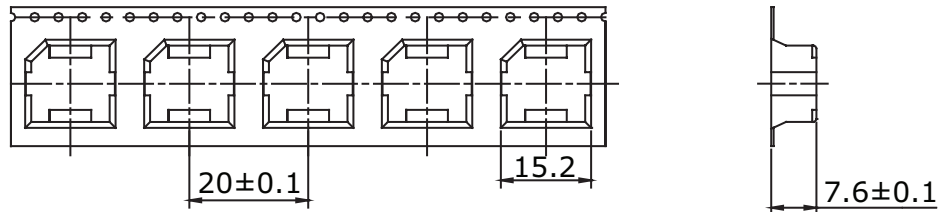
SPL: Voltage vs. Sound Pressure Level
