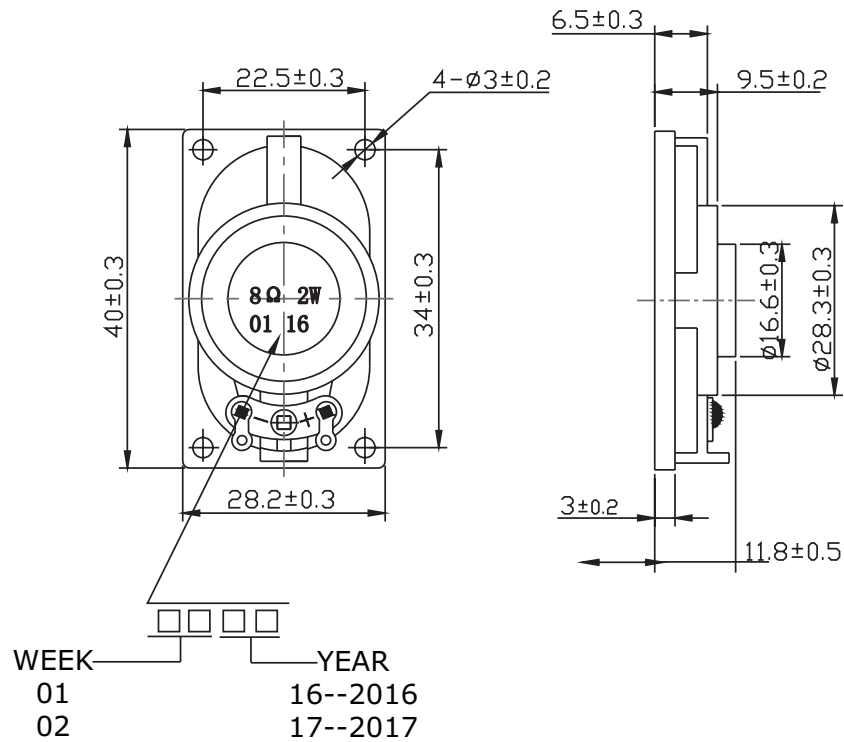

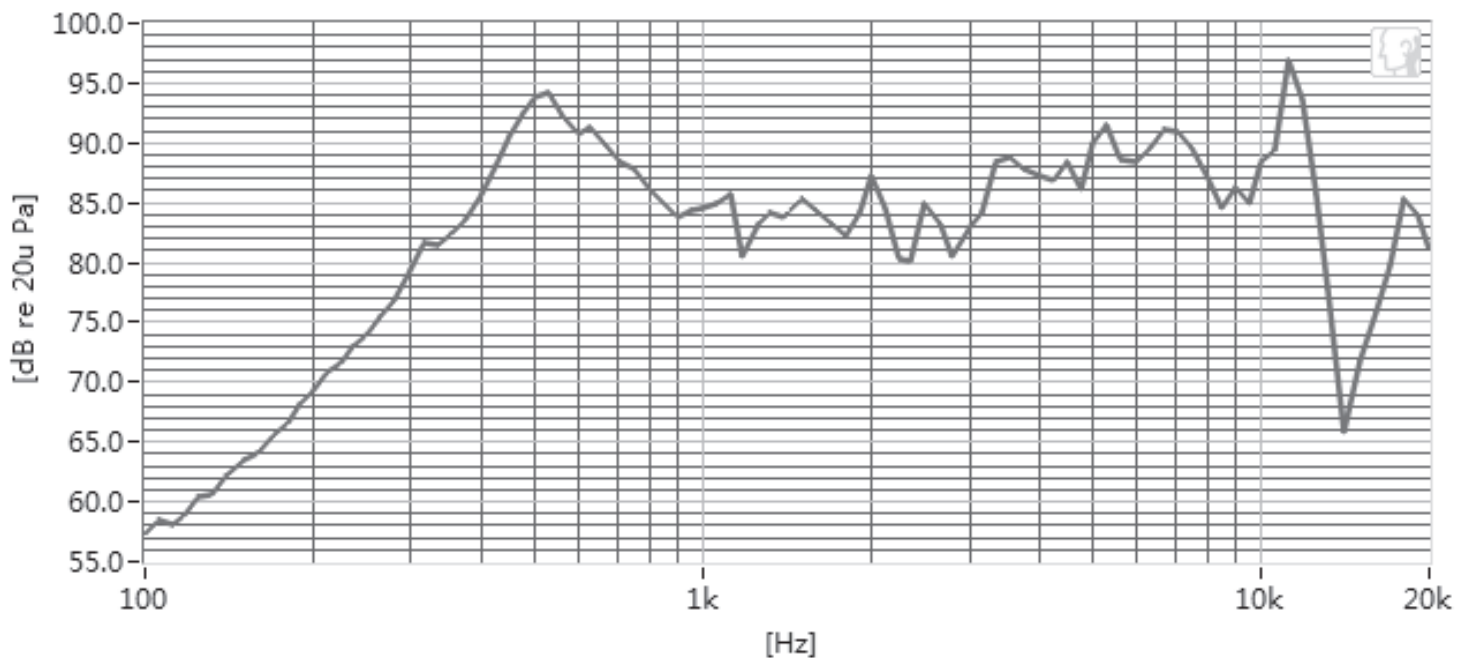

FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE

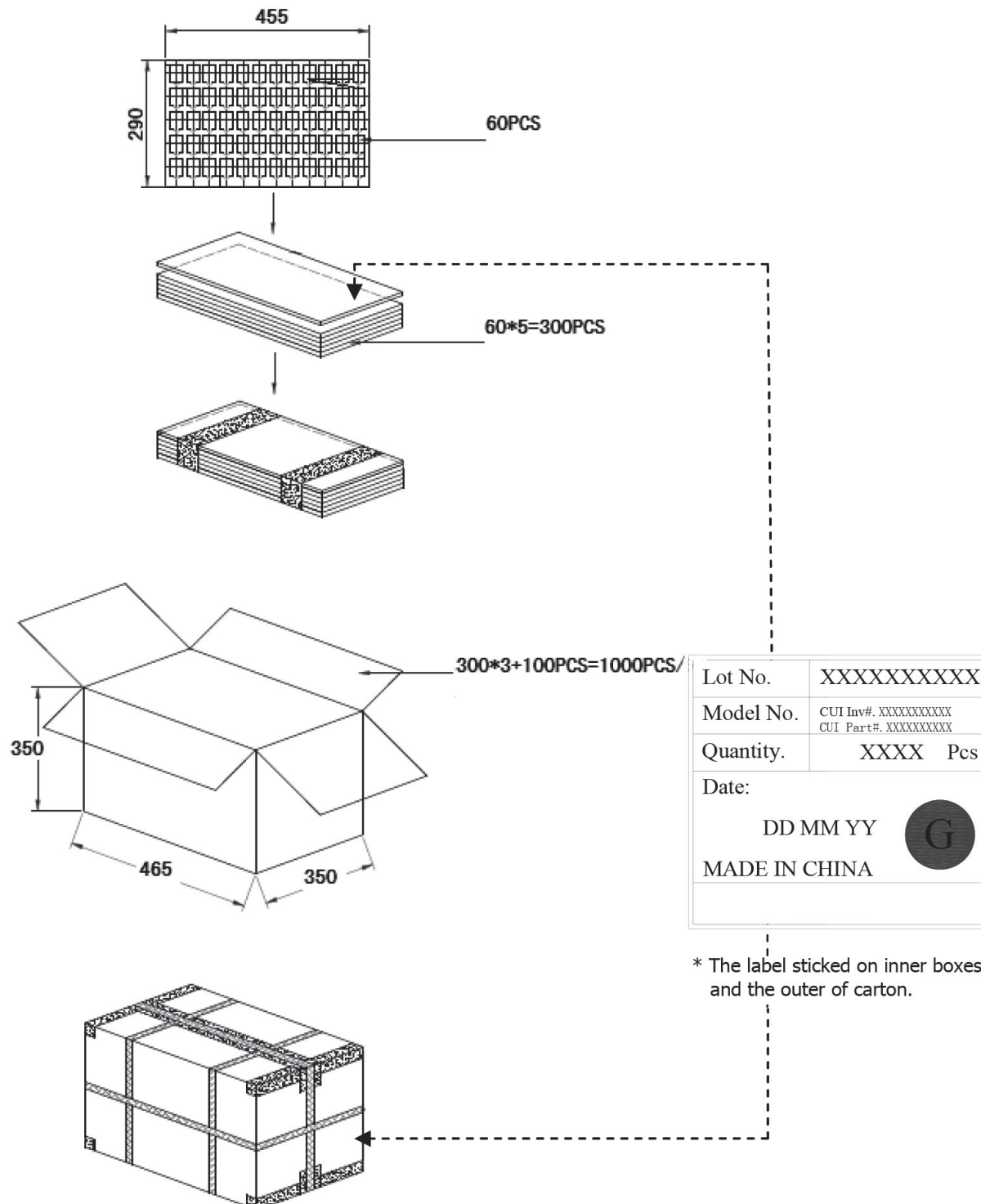
Frequency Response.Magn dB re 20.00 μ PA (at 1 W / 0.3 m)
