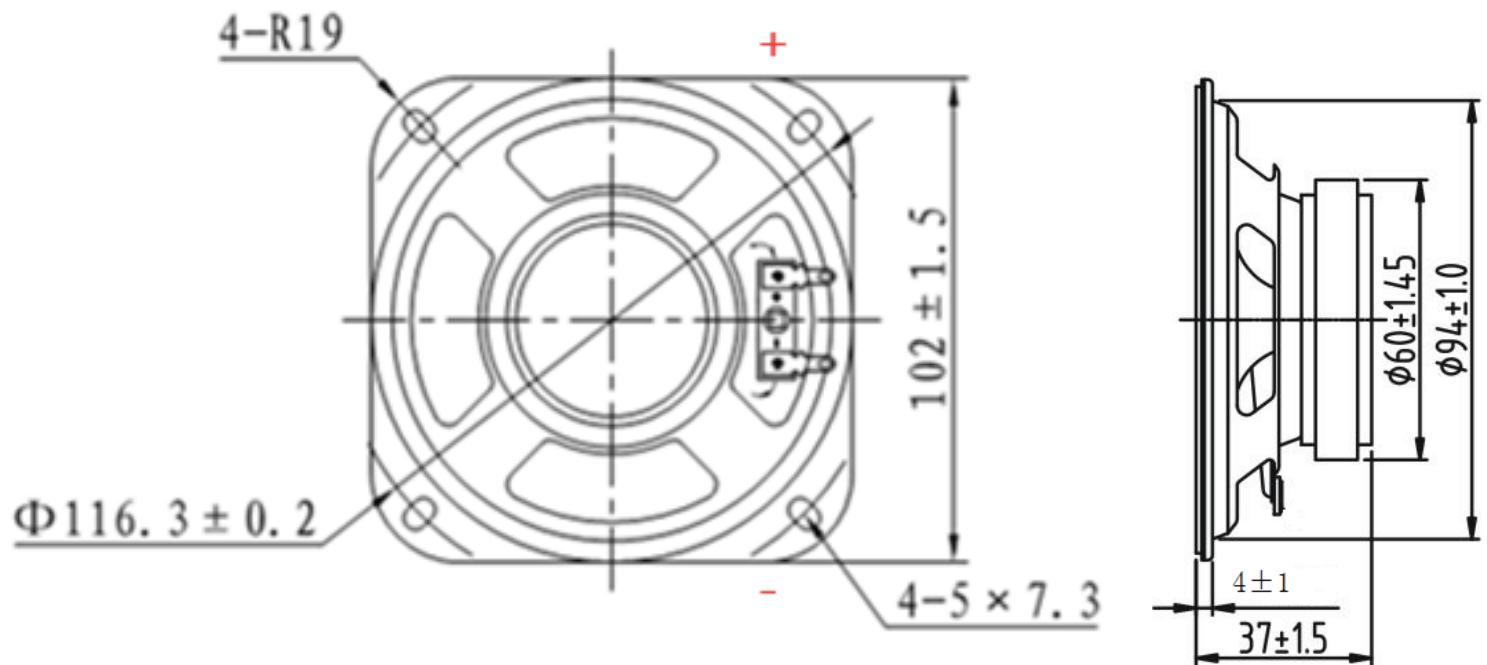

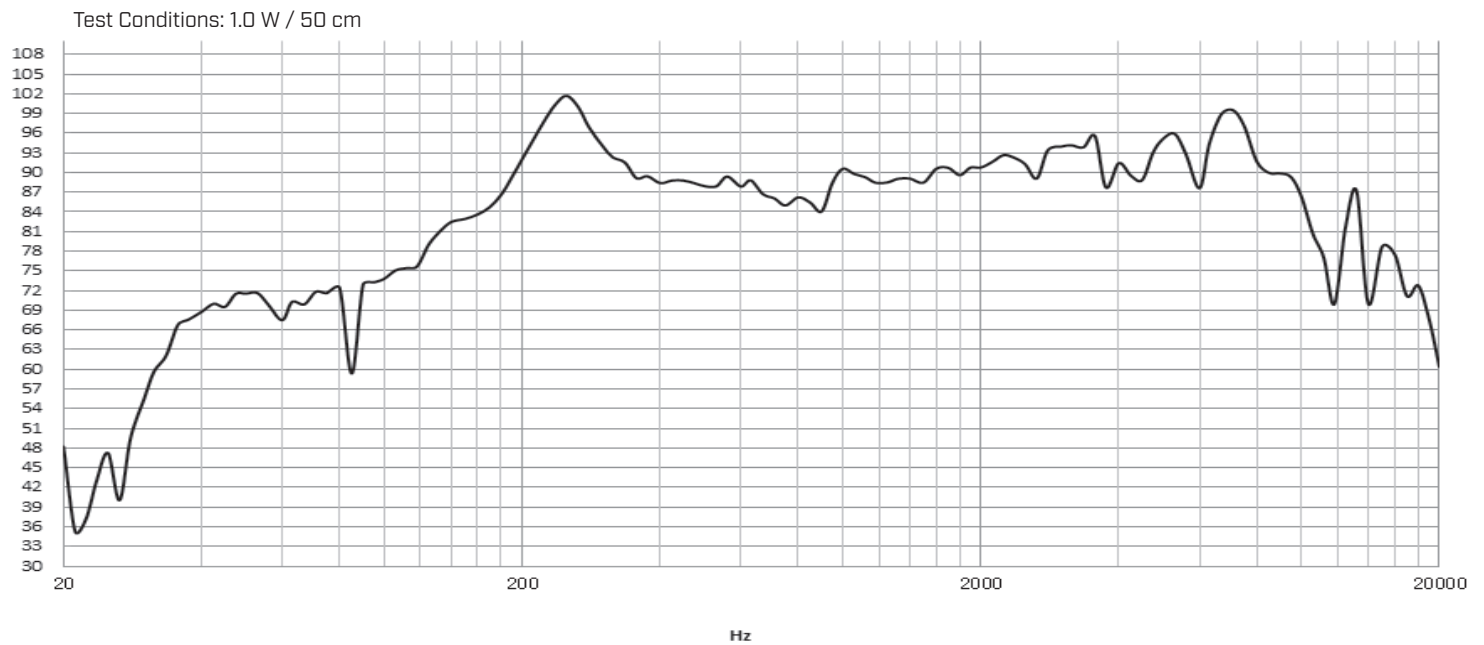

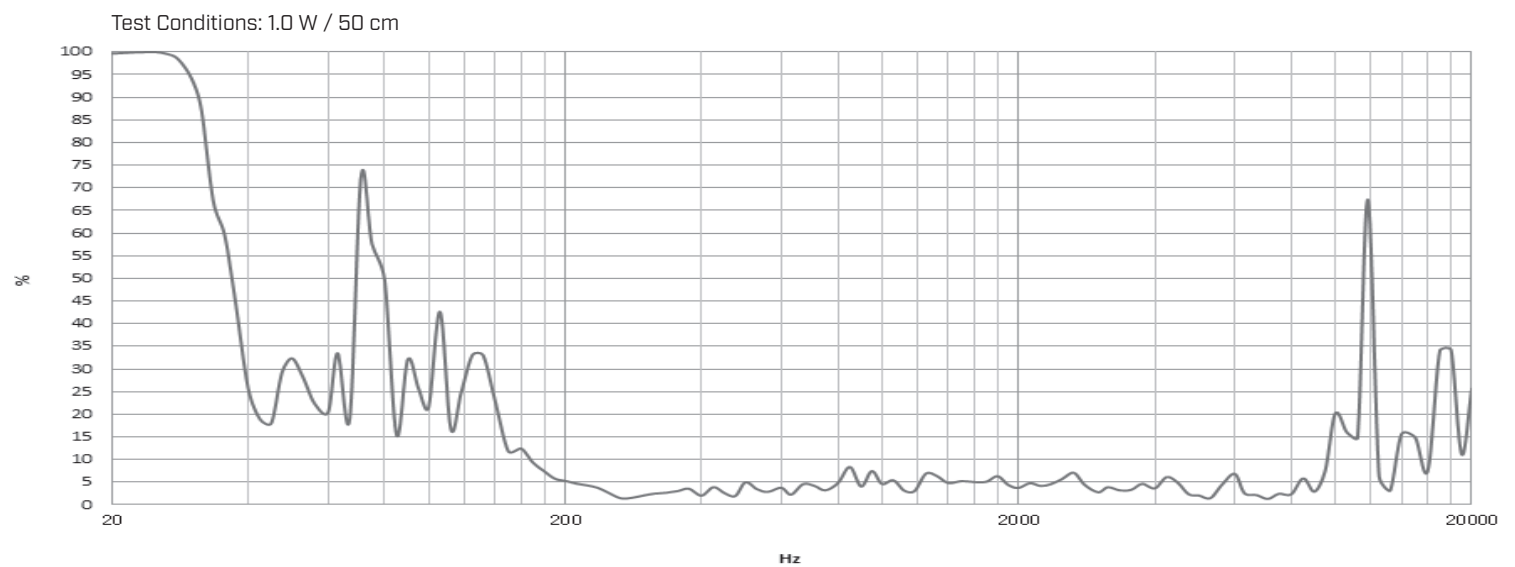


RESPONSE CURVES

Total Harmonic Distortion Curve

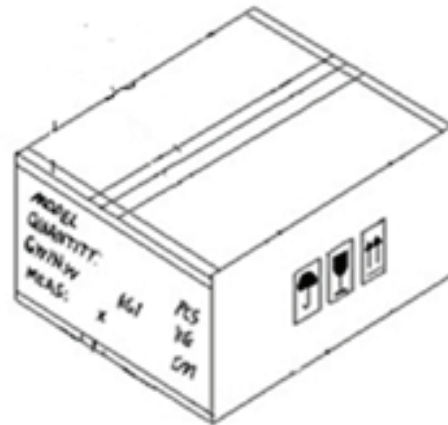
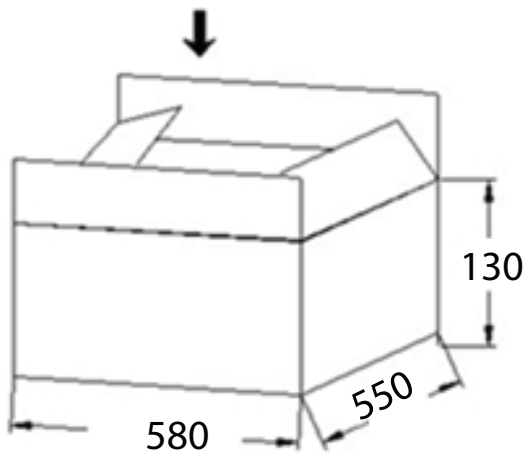
